Instructions for NACA Scholarship Form

Native American Children's Alliance (NACA) is dedicated to assisting tribes and urban Indian Centers to improve their response to child maltreatment. We are particularly interested in providing training and technical assistance in the areas of multi-disciplinary team and child advocacy center development.

This partial scholarship is to help provide lodging for participants attending the **12th Indian Nations conference held in Palm Springs, December 8-11th**. All recipients of this scholarship must attend NACA's pre-conference session on December 8th **Child Sexual Assault: Collaborative Community Response**. Participants should register for this session through the following link: www.regonline.com/ovcinc

This scholarship **does not** cover the Registration fee for the conference. Proof of conference registration is required before NACA pays for lodging expenses. Recipients will be reimbursed for up to 4 nights of lodging, not to exceed \$495.00. The hotel receipt must be included. No incidentals will be allowed.

Participant must register with NACA at its pre-conference session scheduled for December 8th from 8-4:30 and attend the entire session.

Lodging will not be covered if recipient fails to make a commitment to attend all sessions of the conference from Dec 8-11th.
